WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of Monday, the 5th of November, instant, an armed Party entered the House of A. B. Valle, Esq., at Baltrasna, in the County Meath, and took from thence two Stand of Arms, and injured the House, by breaking the doors and windows :

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who were leaders in this Attack,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this Outrage.
